Dear Center Member,

A few weeks ago, I wrote you an urgent letter alerting you to the <u>dangerous and misguided campaign to demonize Israel</u> that is being waged within prominent mainline Protestant church groups across the United States and throughout the world.

Against the wishes of many of their own members -- and contrary to all sense of justice -- leaders in these groups are pushing through a series of punitive actions condemning Israel's security fence and urging divestment from companies doing business with the Jewish State.

Unfortunately, since I wrote you, the situation has grown far more serious. Now, the leader-ship of the General Assembly of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) has adopted a resolution demanding that Israel remove its life-saving barrier against Palestinian terrorism. This would surely cripple Israel's ability to protect her citizens from suicide terror.

In passing this dangerous motion, the Disciples join company with the World Council of Churches, the United Church of Christ and the Presbyterian Church (USA), who are all unfairly targeting the Jewish State.

These politically motivated elite were so eager to ram this measure through, that even the suicide bombing at an Israeli shopping mall -- which murdered two Israeli teens and three other shoppers and left over 100 injured -- just days before the convention did not derail the vote to denounce Israel's most effective, non-lethal anti-terrorism strategy.

I led a Wiesenthal Center delegation to the Disciples of Christ convention and saw first-hand how the membership of this important group was manipulated.

We brought one of the victims of the Café Hillel bombing in 2003 to speak at our Center press conference to protest the Disciples of Christ resolution. She told of the "huge electric shock" of the bomb going off and the eerie split-second of silence just after the explosion. Then she spoke of the piercing screams of the injured, including her own, and the haunting images of the dead.

After reliving for the audience some of the worst moments of her life, she <u>implored</u> the world to unite to act against suicide terrorism.

Outrageously, even as the Disciples of Christ convened to vote on their ill-conceived "Tear Down the Wall" resolution, Disciples President William Hobgood <u>barred the young survivor from speaking directly to the delegates</u> on the floor of the convention.

That she was prohibited from telling her tragic and chilling story exposes the real agenda of those promoting this anti-Israel and functionally antisemitic campaign. Her personal account would have put a human face on the cold statistics of the thousands of other victims of terror -- in Israel and beyond, from London, to Spain, to Baghdad, and elsewhere.

You and I must not let this outrageous and dangerous campaign go unanswered. We must band together now -- in defense of Israel, her people and Jews worldwide -- to declare, "Enough is enough!"

Former Arabic news anchor gives candid view of 'disengagement'

ISRAEL is stepping out in "good faith" again to do whatever it takes to achieve peace with its neighbors – as if Hamas is going to appreciate the goodness of the Jews and re-write its charter and accept Israel as a neighbor and friend.

Hamas has only one goal, and that is to eradicate Israel one piece at a time until it becomes vulnerable to Arab military aggression and conquest. It's Jewish Tikun-Olam (to repair the world) facing Palestinian nationalism and Islamic hatred molded by an Arabic culture of death, revenge and jihad. The implications of this proposed Gaza disengagement will have far-reaching effects – not only for the Israelis, but also for the world.

As one who knows what's in the hearts and minds of Arabs, let me repeat what seems to be the hardest thing for world opinion to accept: The Arabs have no intention of having peace with the Jews – period, exclamation point, end of discussion. No Jews can exist free and unencumbered in the Middle East. "What an outrage. Jews are dhimmis, how dare they come back and live in our midst, make the desert blossom and create a country more advanced than any other in the Middle East. And they don't have any oil!?"

So far, all territorial concessions made by Israel have been in pursuit of an illusion of "land for peace." In Egypt, to whom Israel gave the Sinai Peninsula back in 1979, or Jordan, who signed a peace treaty with Israel, the phone books go from "Ireland" to "Italy" as if Israel never existed. What type of peace is this, without full acknowledgement of statehood? What type of peace is it when the Egyptian government-run and -controlled television airs the "Protocols of the Elders of Zion"?

Previous history gives us ample precedents of what to expect from this disengagement. I watched the growth of unabated terror in Lebanon while my ineffectual government allowed the PLO after "Black September" in 1970, and then Hezbollah during the civil war, to grow unchecked. They fortified towns, stockpiled huge caves with arms and munitions and fired rockets across Israel's northern border. It took a full invasion by Israel to clean them out.

During the IDF's presence in Lebanon, the combined forces of Muslims and Palestinian militias had a philosophy: "Kill a Jew a day and Israeli public opinion will drive Israel out." That's exactly what they succeeded in doing. As Israel retreated from my hometown in Southern Lebanon, the terrorists celebrated victory.

The "Kill Jews and they will pull out" philosophy has been proven successful again in the battle for control of Gaza. This time Hamas and Islamic Jihad taste not only blood, but also the opportunity to attack Israel inside the 1949 Armistice line with Kassem rockets, mortars and anti-aircraft missiles. These shoulder-fired missiles smuggled in via Egypt will be aimed at tourist aircraft taking off and landing at Ben-Gurion airport. RPGs will be launched at civilian vehicles traveling the coastal highway from Quakilya.

Today, there is no Lebanese army in Southern Lebanon – just Hezbollah militia elevated into a terrorist political power as the second-ranking minority party in the new Lebanese parliament, with 21 seats. Hezbollah is one of the most lethal terrorist organizations in the world, with insurgent training centers spinning off terrorists worldwide. Hezbollah's Lebanon experience did not go unnoticed by its brother Hamas in Gaza.

The more Israel is perceived as weak, the more the terrorist hurricane in the Middle East is gaining strength. It's not only going to affect Israel, but the rest of the world as well. The power vacuum the disengagement will create will strengthen Hamas' stature overnight. It will fuel an already burgeoning al-Qaida/Hamas partnership. Intelligence sources say there are plans to create a terror state in Gaza where world terrorist operations will be planned and carried out. This is equivalent to Somalia and Afghanistan terrorist-controlled societies, but within striking distance of Israel proper. The mini-Hamas terror state would have an airport and port facilities from which to export terror to the rest of the world.

U.S. security officials have received multiple confirmations of a meeting in March 2003 between al-Qaida, Hamas and Hezbollah figures. Most alarming is Hamas' move towards embracing global jihad as evidenced by its publishing the messages of Osama bin Laden mentor Abdullah Azzam-Palestinian, originally from Jenin. Hamas openly publicizes its support and alliance with al-Qaida organizations' jihad action in Chechnya, Kashmir, the Balkans and Afghanistan. As al-Qaida associate Jordanian terrorist al-Zarqawi firmed up his relationship with bin Laden in Iraq, it is only a matter of time before Hamas will follow suit under the sovereignty of an independent mini-terror state free from the demands of the weakened PA leadership under Mahmoud Abbas in Ramallah.

According to Jerusalem Data Briefs, there is growing evidence supporting this al-Qaida/Hamas collaboration. In September 2000 and January 2001, after the outbreak of the intifada, bin Laden sent emissaries to Hamas. In 2003, Israel arrested three Hamas militants after they had returned from an al-Qaida training camp

in Afghanistan. Jordanian security officials reported in 2003 that two Hamas agents traveled to Afghanistan to recruit the remnants of al-Qaida, in a Time magazine story, "Hamas Goes Global." Hamas terrorists Eyad Bak and Nabil Ukal were also al-Qaida members who had trained and colluded with other al-Qaida cells.

There is a huge power struggle falling in behind the disengagement process. PLO nationalism, once the motivating factor behind the PA, is rapidly being replaced by Islamic fundamentalism led by Hamas and Islamic Jihad. Calls from mosques and Friday prayers on Palestinian Authority television reinforce the theme of "Death to the Jews." This continued incitement is fueling the raging fire of Islamic Jihad on the march to eradicate the Jews, rather than establishing a two-state solution. No matter how much land Israel gives away, the Arabs will never accept a Jewish state in the Middle East.

After the Gaza pullout in August, if it occurs, chaos will reign supreme. Hamas and Islamic Jihad, with the aid of al-Qaida and Hezbollah, will move in and take over. Thousands of Arabs will pour into "Gaza." They will form an instant terror base from which to attack every corner of Israel, bent on jihad and revenge for "al Nakbah" – "the catastrophe" of their defeat in the 1948 War of Independence.

Israel is engaged in an existential crisis of Armageddon-like proportions. Another "piece for peace"? You have to be kidding, right?

WINSTON CHURCHILL said it best. Prior to the Munich Treaty, "Peace in Our Time" meant a choice "between war and shame." Churchill warned that if Britain chose shame – appeasement – it would get war anyway. That's how it was in 1938.

Today, it defies reality how Israel can make an even worse mistake than the European powers did prior to World War II. Worse because history proves the folly of appeasement – yet Israel ignores history and all the evidence that contradicts any argument in favor of such a policy called "The Gaza disengagement."

I do not believe Ariel Sharon is a traitor, but rather, greatly misguided with his arms twisted by the opinions of the world community. It is possible, also, that he views the withdrawal as a tactic to bring the Jews back to relative safety within "the green line," or other areas which are less costly to defend, so that when the inevitable onslaught comes Israel can use the full weight of its forces to wipe out the enemy.

While in theory this strategy should work, if Israel should decide to use its full load of armor, most people know the world would put incredible pressure to stop Israel from defending itself. We have

already seen the propaganda war against Israel after "Operation Defensive Shield" in Jenin, on the aftermath of the Passover Massacre.

Up till now, Israel has had great success in clamping down on terror and in preventing weapons from being smuggled. During the height of the "second intifada," the cost of a single bullet was a few cents, but today it is over three dollars. The defensive fence, as well as the great work of the Israeli security forces, has been successful in stopping most homicide bombers. The earlier policy of assassinations of terror leaders was also working very well, but world pressure put a stop to them.

We can all complain and bemoan Israel's policy of "disengagement," but we must change our way of thinking when it comes to making the case for Israel. Christians who love Israel, as well as the Jewish people, must take a more proactive stance when it comes to advocating the case. We must stop just reacting to each piece of propaganda put forward by the Arabs and their Palestinian stooges. We must make the case for Israel proactively and tell the world that Judea, Samaria and Gaza belong to Israel and the Jewish people, and we must

attack the enemy for their evil lies and propaganda. The Christian and Jewish community must invest resources in

media. Believe me, it can be done.



FROM JIHADIST TO ZIONIST

Walid Shoebat, born in Bethlehem, began attacking Israelis when he was 8 years old, throwing stones and Molotov cocktails.

"I never actually met any Jews, but in school we were taught from the Quran that they were pigs and monkeys," he says.

By 15, he had already served time in a Jerusalem prison for participating in an anti-Israel riot. While there, he was recruited into the Palestine Liberation Organization. At 16, he was chosen to take a loaf of bread, packed with explosives, to blow up the Bethlehem Bank Leumi. His instructions were to place it in a garbage can near the door of the building. But seeing Arab children playing nearby, he decided to throw the bread on the roof where it did little damage. He once blinded a man during a fight and was "so happy" to learn he was a Jew. He was also involved in the near-lynching of an Israeli soldier.

His motivation? "I wanted to die as a martyr," Walid said. "We were indoctrinated to look forward to heaven."

Shoebat's parents, however, had something else in mind for their son. Fearing he would wind up dead or in prison, they sent him to the United States for college at the age of 18.

But that didn't stop Shoebat's anti-Israeli activism. He continued his recruitment for the PLO on campus. He was the representative for thousands of Palestinian students in Chicago, raising funds, purchasing military uniforms and sending students to fight in Lebanon.

His deep-seated revulsion toward Jews and Israelis continued until he married a Christian woman in 1993. Though he was determined to convert her to Islam, Maria converted him instead.

"She challenged me to find any mistakes in the Bible," he recalls. "So I set out on a six-month journey to do that – to find the errors and convert her."

Instead, he says, after reading the Bible from cover to cover, he determined it was the truth. The computer programmer and his wife were baptized together.

To test his new faith he took a trip to Israel.

"I had still never talked to a Jewish Israeli," he said. "On the plane there, I sat next to a Jewish woman and talked to her. She began crying. I asked her why. She said that she loved her daughters and was worried about them serving in the military. I asked her how they felt killing Palestinians. She replied that they hated killing. I saw a sincerity there that touched me."

Now Shoebat has turned his activism in a completely different direction. He calls himself a Christian Zionist, giving speeches around the U.S. and in Canada. His ultimate dream, he says, is to go to Israeli prisons to teach Palestinian youngsters Jewish history – a dream he understands is fraught with danger from the people who think as he once did. \Box
